- Proper Protective Gloves <u>MUST</u> be worn during the Mine Rescue Team Challenge

Mine Rescue Team Challenge:

Judges Instructions

Merit Point Scoring:

The challenge will not be scored but will be timed.

1. A 5-point demerit will be assessed to any team that does not complete all team challenges.

Rough Handling

- 1. Rough handling demerits will be deducted from the total score
- 2. Judges can deduct 1 to 5 points per incident of rough handling of equipment
- 4. Rough handling demerits will have a maximum of 10 points
- 3. Rough handling deductions must be explained by the judges



MINE RESCUE TEAM CHALLENGE EXPLINATION OF EVENT:

Each member of the (6) person team will compete in each challenge while being timed by the judges. The cumulative time of the (6) persons will be recorded for the total time for the team. Judges will start the clock when the first team member begins the first challenge and a judge will stop the clock when the final team member completes the last challenge. Team can complete the challenges in any order that they chose but they must complete all challenges to avoid a 5-point team demerit.

Team members will work in a consecutive manner, i.e., Team Member #1 will complete all four (4) segments. Team #1 must complete the Carry Challenge, Fire Hose Layout, Sledge Hammer and Timber sawing challenges before Team Member #2 Starts.

The Clock will start when Team Member #1 begins the first challenge segment.

- When Team Member #1 completes all 4 challenge segments a Judge will instruct Team Member #2 to begin, clock will remain running.
- When Team Member #2 completes all 4 challenge segment a Judge will instruct Team Member #3 to begin, clock will remain running.
- When Team Member #3 completes all 4 challenge segments a Judge will instruct Team Member #4 to begin, clock will remain running.
- When Team Member #4 completes all 4 challenge segment a Judge will instruct Team Member #5 to begin, clock will remain running.
- When Team Member #5 completes all 4 challenge segment a Judge will instruct Team Member #6 to begin, clock will remain running.

When Team Member #6 completes all 4 challenge segments the clock will be stopped.
