Judging applicants must meet one or more of the following requirements: Technical Requirements:

1. Current, active participation in the training, administration or development of underground Mine Rescue programs, procedures or emergency response.

2. Current or previous training and experience in the use of oxygen breathing apparatus and current or previous certification for use by local Mine Rescue oversight body or Mine Operator.

3. Trained in the application of first aid/casualty care principles.

4. Trained in the safe application of firefighting principles in underground Mine Rescue.

5. Familiar with underground mining conditions and practice.

Language Requirements

1. Judges must have a working proficiency in speaking/understanding technical mining English.

2. Judges must have a working proficiency in reading/writing technical mining English.

Physical Requirements

1. All Judges must be physically fit, and capable of performing physical labor.

Previous Competition Experience

1. Consideration will be given to Judges with previous experience as a judge, volunteer or competitor in Mine Rescue competitions, both internationally and domestic.

2. Judges are encouraged to outline their Mine Rescue competition history, including participation as judges, volunteers or team members, including any results or experience of significance.

Competition Events

Judges must rank their proficiency in:

- Mine Rescue
- Firefighting
- First Aid/Casualty Care
- High Angle Rope Rescue
- Emergency Simulations
- Oxygen Breathing Apparatus
- Gas Detection
- Incident Command
